BUILT-IN SUPPORT FOR IP NETWORK CAMERAS

Iomega StorCenter devices automatically discover Axis®-branded video cameras on your network through its built-in EMC® LifeLine™ software, and the easy-to-use configuration tool makes it easy to set up your camera in just minutes.

If your camera is not Axis-branded, just follow the camera vendor's instructions and select the StorCenter as the storage target (typically an FTP or HTTP target). The StorCenter supports the right network protocols to work with most network cameras.

LIVE VIDEO VIEWING FROM ANYWHERE

Watch live video of your home or business from any networked computer or other device, including handheld devices like your iPhone.

IMMEDIATE OR SCHEDULED RECORDING

For added convenience, you can either initiate recording manually or schedule it to take place automatically.

EXPANDABILITY

If you need another camera, just add it to the network. Your StorCenter will automatically find it. (The total number of cameras supported varies with the StorCenter model as well as overall network activity.)

ENABLING VIDEO SURVEILLANCE

1. Click the **Lifeline Storage Manager** icon in the System Tray (Windows) or Menu Bar (Mac). If you have more than one StorCenter device, right-click the icon and select the device you would like to set up for video surveillance.
2. Click the **Settings** tab.
3. Click the **Media Services** tab.
4. Click the **Video Surveillance** tab.
5. All of your network cameras will automatically be listed. Click the wrench icon next to the camera that you want to configure. *NOTE: you can also click the monitor icon and see live video from your camera, or click the record button to start a manual recording.*
6. If you have a security password on your camera, enter your username and password and click **Next**.
7. Configure your camera for scheduled recordings and how to store your recordings. Then click **Apply**.

For non-Axis cameras:

1. Navigate to your network camera settings following the camera vendor's instructions.
2. Adjust the settings to use a folder on your StorCenter device as a recording target. (This is usually an FTP, HTTP or motion detection setting.)
